Batch A — MVP2 Collections Depth (W4-2, W4-3, W4-4)

Estimated: 1,400 LOC, 2-3 days

- **W4-2: Uplift Scorer** (`/lib/uplift-scorer.ts`)
 - Deterministic formula: $P(\text{payment}) \times \text{Lift} \times \text{Amount} \times \text{StrategicRiskMultiplier}$
 - Learns customer payment behavior per Behavior table
 - Outputs daily ranked worklist
- **W4-3: Collections Orchestrator**
 - Multi-strategy runner (Strategy A control vs. Strategy B experimental)
 - Email drafting (soft/firm/assertive tones)
 - Escalation detection (cadence breaks, credit drops, legal risk)
 - Strategy performance comparison (A/B test runner)
- **W4-4: Collections Golden Cases + Agreement Dashboard**
 - SME labeling UI (strategy, action, escalation)
 - Agreement dashboard for MVP2 (strategy agreement, escalation agreement)
 - Weekly trend, drift alerts

Batch B — MVP3 Invoice Depth (W4-5, W4-6, W4-7)

Estimated: 1,250 LOC, 2-3 days

- **W4-5: Invoice Validity Engine**
 - Implements `InvoiceValidityCheck` table (5-dimension logic)

- PO match, GR match, price variance, tax validation, duplicate detection
- Composite verdicts: Auto-Approve, Hold-For-Review, Reject
- **W4-6: Invoice Closed-Loop Learning**
 - Override capture: when analyst rejects agent proposal
 - Pattern clustering (e.g., “3-way match failures on size-variant items”)
 - Prompt refinement proposals
 - A/B testing on refined prompts
- **W4-7: Invoice Golden Cases + Agreement Dashboard**
 - SME labeling UI (case type, exception type, action)
 - Agreement dashboard for MVP3 (classification agreement, exception agreement)

Batch C — MVP4 Buyer Depth (W4-8, W4-9, W4-10)

Estimated: 1,350 LOC, 2-3 days

- **W4-8: Buyer Policy Engine**
 - Implements policy evaluation (spend thresholds, supplier eligibility, category restrictions)
 - Enforcement modes: hard_block, soft_warn, log_only
 - Approval chain routing (who approves based on violation type?)
- **W4-9: PR/PO Orchestrator**
 - Conversational input → structured PR proposal
 - Policy compliance checks
 - Approval routing
 - Execution (create PO in ERP)
- **W4-10: Buyer Golden Cases + Agreement Dashboard**
 - SME labeling UI (scenario category, true action, true policy result)
 - Agreement dashboard for MVP4 (policy agreement, proposal agreement)

Batch D — Cross-MVP Trust (W4-11)

Estimated: 550 LOC, 1-2 days

- **W4-11: Cross-MVP Trust Score**
 - Nightly computation of `CrossMvpAgreementSnapshot`
 - Platform trust score (weighted composite of all MVP agreements)
 - Executive trust dashboard enhancement (show cross-MVP metrics)
 - Value ledger rollup (realized + projected value per MVP, total)

Unlocks: Slide 47 (platform trust score), enhanced Executive Dashboard

Known Constraints & Decisions

1. **No authentication required** — App is POC, open access
2. **Simulated MCP tools** — Replace with real ERP/CRM APIs in customer pilot
3. **Deterministic data generation** — Reproducible for demos (no randomness in seed)
4. **PostgreSQL + Prisma** — Not SQLite; proper enterprise DB
5. **Next.js 14 only** — No Next.js 15 (not supported in build environment)
6. **Decimal type for financials** — Precise to \$0.01
7. **Immutable audit log** — Append-only, hash-chained
8. **Weekly snapshots** — Agreement, cost, drift, value all weekly

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Credit & Context

Project Goal: AI Operations Center for \$4B frozen/refrigerated food manufacturer. MVP1 focus (Trade Deductions). Scalable to 5 agents (Collections, Invoice, Buyer, Demand). Enterprise-grade: governance, audit, agreement-with-human metrics.

Why Waves?

- Wave 1-2: Foundation (MCP, Writeback, Audit, HITL, Eval, Cost, Drift)
- Wave 3: MVP1 depth (7 parts → full validity engine, orchestration, testing, governance)
- Wave 4: Cross-MVP enterprise (apply Wave 3 patterns to MVP2/3/4, cross-MVP trust score)
- (Implicit Wave 5+): Hardening, production connectors, scale to 1M+ decisions/year

Why This Approach?

- **One MVP at depth** (Wave 3 MVP1) before spreading (Wave 4 MVPs 2-4). Prevents thin spread.
 - **Enterprise patterns early** (governance, HITL, agreement, closed-loop). Not bolted on later.
 - **Testable at every step** (19 test scenarios, golden cases, cost meter). Quality baked in.
 - **Value quantified** (\$88M annualized at full platform). Not hypothetical.
